Look What's Happened In School Over The Holidays

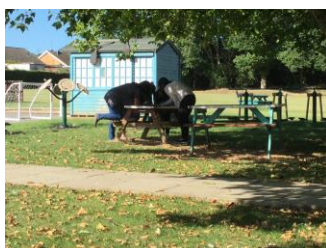
Here are some of our lovely changes around our school.
