## English

In English this half term, Year 4 will be looking at setting descriptions. The children will be reading the text 'Leon and the Place between' and writing their own version of this story using fantastic adjectives to impress the reader. Our second topic this half term is persuasive writing. This will be linked with our Pollution topic in Geography and pupils will be creating a leaflet to persuade their fellow pupils to join the litter picking club.

#### Mathematics

For Maths this half term, Year 4 will continue to work on multiplication and division. They will be looking at multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000 and will be using the formal written methods to support them when multiplying three-digit numbers by one-digit numbers. After this, children will briefly recap length and perimeter before moving on to fractions. During our fraction topic, pupils will be able to compare and order fractions, convert between mixed number and improper fractions, understand equivalent fractions and finally they will be adding and subtracting.

### Geography:

This half term, we will be looking at pollution. Year 4 will be covering where our waste comes from, the damage pollution causes and the ways we can reduce pollution. Children will also be linking this to their English work when creating a persuasive leaflet on joining the litter picking club.



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#### Science:

In Science we will be looking at classification keys and will be creating our own. We will cover the difference between vertebrates and invertebrates and will look closely at the difference between mammals, fish, reptiles, amphibians, and birds. We will also be having a visit from The Bird Man for Science week.

**RE**: In RE this half term, we will be looking at Christianity. Pastor William will be coming in to visit us and talk about forgiveness and why this is so important to Christians.

**PE**: In PE this half term, we will be covering netball. This will be on Thursdays for Heron class. Finch class will be swimming on Friday mornings.

DT: In DT this half term, we will be designing and creating a stuffed Easter toy. We will be learning how to blanket stitch and applique.

#### Computing

Over the Spring half term, our topic is 'Creating media: Website design'. During this topic, we will use most of the tabs (e.g. insert, pages, themes) on Google Sites on their website, create a clear plan for a web page and begin to create it. We will make a professional looking web page with useful information and a clear style, which is easy for the user to read and find information from and finally, create a clear plan by referring to a checklist.
