*In line with the latest Government and Local Authority advice, as a school we are actively promoting good hygiene as the best prevention measure during the current viral outbreak.*

*In addition to reminders in class and in assemblies, we have shared good hand washing practice with all the children. They have watched a video and discussed hygiene in class in general terms without raising or causing alarm. Plenty of soap, paper towels and tissues are available in all classrooms and bins are emptied daily. The advice is that hand gel is not the best prevention measure and as a school we are not allowed to give it to children because of the alcohol content.
