English

Traditional Tales

Children will be writing traditional tales, they will reflect on the main character of the legend from different viewpoint and re-tell the story from several different perspectives

Non Fiction (Explanation)

Children will write an explanation text for physical geography e.g. climate zones, river, mountains, earthquakes and volcanoes.

Mathematics

Fractions

This term, pupils are investigating fractions. Identifying, converting, adding and subtracting mixed numbers and improper fractions.

Pupils will also order and compare fractions based on their numerators and denominators.

Geography

Ciao Bambini! (Italy)

In this unit, Children will discover both physical and human features of Italy, comparing the UK to cities in Italy to explore our differences and similarities.



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Science – Changing materials

This Changing Materials unit will teach your class about different materials, their uses and their properties, as well as dissolving, separating mixtures and irreversible changes. The children will sort and classify objects according to their properties. They will explore the properties of materials to find the most suitable material for different purposes

RE - Christianity

Is the Christmas story true? Do sacred texts have to be 'true' to help people understand their religion? These are questions that children will be investigating during this topic.

PE – Gymnastics

In PE, children are focusing on performing different types of rolls, balances and handstands. Over the course of the topic, children will put everything they have practised together into a choreographed routine.

Design and Technology – Italian Pasta Salads

Children will look at common ingredients found in a pasta salad, how to plan a recipe and craft their own pasta salads based on their own design.

Computing – Programming music

In this unit, children will use scratch to programme a soundtrack. Children will focus on including repetition and explain its function to enhance music. Children will code a piece of music that combines a variety of structures and instruments.
