However, as a school, we have decided to keep all of our safety measures in place until the end of term, including bubbles, staggered starts and our one-way system - nothing will change before the end of the summer term. We hope this brings consistency and reassurance for everyone as we bring the year to a close.

There is one change from Monday that we will be making regarding the reporting of positive COVID cases. From Step 4, schools will no longer be expected to undertake tracing of close contacts - close contacts of a positive case will now be identified via NHS Test and Trace.
