I am sure you have seen yesterday's announcement regarding the return of primary schools by the Education Secretary. It has been confirmed that schools in certain Tier 4 areas will remain closed to most children in January (to be reviewed on the 18<sup>th</sup>) including primary schools in the area of Broxbourne. Learning will be online for a majority of children.

If you are a critical worker and absolutely need your child to attend school, the fewer children making the journey to school and attending an educational settings the lower the risk that the Covid-19 virus can spread within our school and our community. If it is possible for your child to remain at home, then they should do so.
