### English

This term our writing will focus on narratives. We will be using the text 'Leon and the Place Between' as our key text.

The children will take inspiration to write their own circus-based narrative.

### Mathematics

The children will continue to work on the decimal's unit. This term they will learn to apply their knowledge of decimals to make links with measurements.

In the second part of the term the children will develop their learning of measuring the perimeter of a range of shapes.

Throughout the term we will continue with our strong emphasis on learning our times tables up to 12 x 12 due to the times table check that will take place in the summer.

### Geography

This term our focus will be on different types of pollution. We will begin with identifying different types of waste and then move on to exploring different ways to reduce the negative effects of pollution.





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### Science

We will explore a variety of ways to identify, sort, group and classify living things. The children will learn how animals are split into 'vertebrates' and 'invertebrates' and begin to consider the differences between living things within these classifications. They will use and create classification keys to group, identify and name living things from the local habitat and beyond.

### RE

This term's focus will be on Easter. The children will explore the concept of resurrection and the importance of this belief to Christians.

### PE

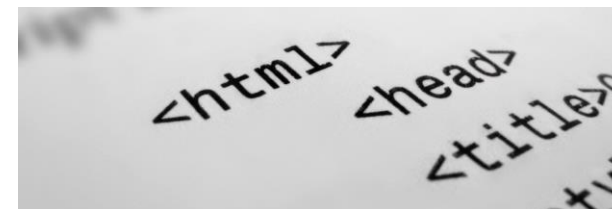
