Equipment needed

- -Drink bottle- named
- -plastic mug for hot drinks
- -torch
- -A few small healthy snacks- no sweet or nuts please
- -waterproof trousers
- waterproof coat

long sleeve tops/ thermals and trousers/ leggings- there are mosquitoes about and children may go home with bites or nettle stings.

- old trainers/ walking boots that children can lace themselves or wellies with 2 pairs of socks/ welly liners (no open school shoes)
- -spare clothes, especially socks, for if your child gets wet
- a carrier bag with a name on or other waterproof bag e.g waterproof shopping bag
- -hat & gloves
- -insect repellent (warmer weather only)

It is essential that your children have the correct clothing for forest school. We will call you to collect your child early if they are cold or wet and we can't keep them warm or dry.

What goes on at forest school after school club?

Den building & construction, nature crafts, learning about nature, bushcrafting, cooking over an open fire, team games, hammocks, games in the dark and more! We are completely self sufficient. A hand's free wash station is available in the woods but we have access to the toilets.

What happens when it rains?

We have a large parachute and tarpaulin and we'll all wear our coats & waterproofs. If the weather is very windy or stormy, we'll take forest school indoors where possible or postpone the session. In the warmer months, we ask children wear long sleeve tops and trousers. This helps prevent biting insects and nettle stings. Please be prepared!
