- **P.E.**  
Please provide a named white t-shirt and a pair of black shorts in a labelled drawstring bag. For health and safety reasons, we advise all studs and other items of jewellery are removed on P.E days. If studs cannot be removed, then please provide micro tape.
- **Footwear**  
Please could provide your child with a pair of wellington boots to be kept at school- **clearly named**.
- **Snack Times**  
All children under 5 are entitled to a free carton of milk, after this you will need to complete the forms at the beginning of each term and return to the office. In addition, your child is also entitled to a piece of fruit or vegetable which is 1 of their 5 a-day portion. Please let us know if your child has any allergies or cannot have certain foods due to religious reasons.
- **Reading Books**  
Children are encouraged to access a range of picture books from the classroom. Once we have assessed your child's reading ability and understanding we will send home reading scheme books matched to your child's ability. Please make time to share your child's reading successes by writing short comments in their reading record every time you read. We advise that you read with your child daily to build their confidence and interest in books. Please ensure your child has their **reading book and reading record in their bag every day**.
