English		Maths	
<p>Narrative</p> <p>During this unit, the children will be looking at a traditional tales. We will be focussing on stories with recurring literacy language and the children will be innovating it by changing the characters and some of the events, while maintaining the same structure of the story.</p> <p>Report</p> <p>We will be linking our history topic to writing reports. We will be writing a newspaper report based on past Kings and Queens.</p> <p>Poetry</p> <p>In our poetry unit we will be writing diamante poems. We will be working on the structure and using adjectives.</p>		<p>Multiplication</p> <p>While the children have already been working hard learning their times tables, we will be looking deeper into what multiplication is and how it works. They will be making and adding equal groups together, as well as using arrays to aid their learning.</p> <p>Money</p> <p>In Mathematics, we have started to look at money, ensuring the children recognise the different coins and notes. We will be building on their addition and subtraction skills by getting them to choose coins and notes to make certain amounts and working out change.</p>

<p>Through guided reading sessions and daily read for twenty; we will be focusing on retrieval, inference and vocabulary skills.</p>		<p>Animals, including humans: This half term we will be looking into why we should live a healthy lifestyle; importance of exercise, eating the right foods and hygiene.</p>
