<b>English</b>		<b>Maths</b>	
In English, we will be using the texts 'Voices in the Park' and 'Where's my Teddy?' to inspire our writing outcomes. This term, we will be writing a story and a non-chronological report.		In Maths, we will be exploring numbers up to 20, learning how to represent them in different ways and how to write them as words. We will begin to compare and order numbers to 20.	
<b>Reading</b>		<b>Science</b>	
This half term, we will continue to review our phase three, four and five sounds. We will be learning new alternate sounds and as always, will be building our knowledge and confidence in blending new sounds to read words.		In Science, we will continue to learn about seasonal change. We will explore what happens to the trees – what happens to evergreen trees? What clothes do we wear in Winter? How does the day length differ to the Summer?	
<b>Art</b>		<b>Geography</b>	
In Art, we will be exploring the theme of rain using different mediums such as water colour paint, pastel and pencil.		In Geography, we will learn about seasons and the common weather that comes with each season. We will explore different types of weather and learn how to record and measure the weather. We will compare our climate with the polar climate, noticing similarities and differences.	
<b>Religious Education</b>		<b>Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)</b>	
In RE, we will continue to learn about Christianity. We will be learning to identify when it is easy and difficult to show friendship.		<b>Dreams and Goals:</b> This term we will focus on setting simple goals and working out how to achieve them, working well with a partner, tackling new challenges and overcoming obstacles.
