English		Maths	
In English, we will be looking at The Lighthouse Keeper and Clean Up, to inspire our writing outcomes. We will be writing a narrative and a persuasive advert.		In Maths, we will be exploring the wonderful world of multiplication. Children will be learning to count forwards and backwards in twos, fives and tens. We will begin to recognise equal groups and use this to arrange objects in columns and rows as arrays. We will explore doubles, grouping and sharing.	
Reading		Science	
In Phonics, we will be revisiting our phase five sounds. We will continue our daily guided reading sessions and will be building on our comprehension skills.		This term, we will be exploring the five senses. We will explore the use of our senses through practical activities and discuss why they are important along with what they are used for.
