English		Maths	
<p>This half term, children will focus on revising key spelling, punctuation, and grammar (SPaG) objectives to prepare for their SATs. Areas of study will include word classes, as well as understanding and using synonyms and antonyms. Pupils will also review how to identify and use active and passive voice in sentences.</p>		<p>Throughout this term we will continue consolidating children's problem-solving skills. This will involve reasoning with money, measure, and shape. We will recap efficient strategies for solving problems involving time, as well as recording data and making inferences based on data given. We will also continue working on calculating arithmetic questions with speed and accuracy.</p>	
Reading		Science	
<p>This half-term we will be focusing on shorter fiction and non-fiction texts that will consolidate the children's learning of the reading content domains from the National Curriculum.</p>		<p>Animals including Humans: This unit recaps the children's learning from year 4 about how animals survive and stay healthy and helps children to learn more about how different organ systems work. This unit teaches the importance of diet, exercise and lifestyle in the way that bodies function. In this unit, they learn about the three main parts of the circulatory system and the job of the heart.</p>	
Art		History	
<p>Recycled Art: Children will explore appropriate joins, materials and paint to use when creating a recycled art piece that represents something or sends a message to their audience.</p>		<p>The Post-War Decades: During this unit children will explore one of the most exciting and fast-moving centuries of all time. They will look at the changes in post war Britain (decade by decade) focusing on areas such as: home life, work life, popular culture, technology and political movements.</p>

They will explore mental health and the importance of taking care of it.</p>

<p>What is the date?</p> <p>Days of the week, months of the year and numbers 1-31 will be introduced, revised and consolidated so, by the end of this unit, pupils will have the knowledge and skills to say the date and when their birthday is in Spanish.</p>		<p>Athletics: Children will build on their athletic skills in preparation for Sports Day. They will practice individual running races, hurdles, and team relay games. They will also develop their javelin throwing skills.</p>

<p>Exploring AI.</p> <p>Pupils will explore what AI is and how it generates text, images and code. Pupils will also learn about creating and refining prompts to improve AI responses while also considering the ethical implications of AI and its potential to replace human roles.</p>		<p>Music and Me</p> <p>This series of lesson will focus on inspirational women working in music. It is part of a wider gender equality initiative and looks into how women are underrepresented in the industry.</p>
