English		Maths	
Children will be writing a narrative from an alternative perspective. Later this term, children will study playscripts before composing their own.		Pupils will learn to add and subtract decimals with a different number of decimal places. Following this, children will learn about negative numbers and units of measurement.	
Reading		Science	
Children will read the mystery story 'Clockwork' by Philip Pullman.		This unit of learning is called 'Animals including humans'. Children study the different developmental stages of human life, gestation periods and life expectancies.
