English		Maths	
In English will look closely at the story 'The Lion Inside' by Rachel Bright and Jim Field as inspiration for the children's writing. The children will build up to an outcome of writing simple sentences using patterned language, words and phrases taken from familiar stories.		In Maths, we will be exploring numbers between 50 to 100. We will be looking closely at partitioning numbers, thinking carefully about how many tens and how many ones each digit represents. We will then also be thinking about money: recognising the value of different coins and notes. Then we end the term thinking about 'Time', following on from last term where we looked at o'clock and half past.	
Reading		Science	
In Phonics, we will be revisiting our phase 5 sounds. We will continue our daily guided reading sessions and will be building on our comprehension skills		This term, we will be exploring the world of Animals, including Humans. We will look at sorting animals into different groups and finding out similarities and differences between these groups.	
Art		History	
This term our Art topic will be 'Sea collage'. During this topic, we will describe the shades of colour seen in different seaside objects and explore the different textures of objects found at the seaside.		This term, we will be inspired by our topic of 'Seaside Holidays in the Past, focusing on the Victorian Times.'. We will be thinking about how the seaside holidays are the same now and how they are different: clothing, activities, even sun tan lotion (which wasn't invented in then).
