English		Maths	
Children will be studying letter writing for different purposes. Children will then write their own letter of complaint. Later in the term, pupils will write narrative stories.		Pupils will continue to learn about fractions, decimals and percentages. Following this, children will learn how to find the area and perimeter of shapes.	
Reading		Science	
Children will read the fantasy story 'Malamander' by Thomas Taylor.		This unit of learning is all about materials and their properties. Pupils will learn about reversible and irreversible changes.	
Design Technology		Geography	
This unit of learning is all about Pop up books. Pupils will learn crafting techniques before planning and creating their own pop up book.		Year Five will be studying about volcanoes and the planet Earth in their topic 'Journey to the centre of the Earth'.	
Religious Education		Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)	
Pupils will be learning about Holy Week and the build up to Easter. Pupils will consider the significance of Jesus's death.		In the 'Healthy Me' unit, pupils will look at how to keep their bodies healthy. They will learn about good and bad habits.	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
This unit teaches pupils to have the knowledge and skills to make a presentation about their own/a fictitious family.		In the fitness unit, pupils will take part in a range of activities that explore and develop their strength, stamina, speed, co-ordination, balance and agility.	
Computing		Music	
In this computing unit, pupils will learn about different types of animation. They will plan and create their own stop motion animation.		All the learning is focused around one song: The Fresh Prince Of Bel-Air. The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, the interrelated dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc.), singing and playing instruments are all linked.
