English		Maths	
In English, we will be looking at Kehlani the Koala and the Koala who could, to inspire our writing outcomes. We will be writing a narrative and a letter.		In Maths, the children will be learning about numbers up to fifty. They will be learning how to count forwards and backwards and build their knowledge of tens and ones.	
Reading		Science	
In Phonics, we will be revisiting our phase five sounds. We will continue our daily guided reading sessions and will be building on our comprehension skills.		This term, we will be learning all about plants including naming parts of a plant. The children will have the opportunity to plant their own seeds and to make observations on how they grow over time.
