English		Maths	
<p>Narrative (Fiction Genres): During this unit, the children will be looking at familiar stories with a focus on stories with recurring literacy language. We will be working towards using familiar stories as a model to write a new story.</p> <p>Non – Fiction: The children will be using the text The day the crayons quit to plan and write a formal letter.</p>		<p>Multiplication & Division We are consolidating our knowledge of what multiplication is and how it works, as well as investigating its relationship to division. We will be looking at division as both grouping and sharing. While focussing on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables we will also be looking at dividing by 2, 5 and 10</p>	
Reading		Science	
<p>We will continue to work on our VIPER skills this half term.</p> <p>Children will be reading detectives to work on inference skills, to explore a text more fully. We will build on our vocabulary and comprehension skills through a selection of high-quality picture books.</p>		<p>Animals including humans: Ponds Our science topic is focusing on how animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. We will be looking at lifecycles of both humans and animals and we will have a specific focus on ponds and the wildlife found in and around ponds.</p>	
Design Technology		Geography	
<p>Castles: In this unit, children will be using their knowledge of castles from their history work last half term to test out materials for a castle wall and choose materials to produce an effective movement mechanism. From this, they will plan, make and evaluate a model castle.</p>		<p>We are Britain! In this unit, children will be learning all about the 4 nations which make up the UK, focussing on each country separately. We will also be looking in more detail about England, investigating its culture and traditions and learning about London, the Capital City of UK.</p>

<p>Religion: Christianity/ Easter- The children will be learning about Jesus’ resurrection. They will be thinking about ‘How important is it to Christians that Jesus came back to life after his crucifixion?’</p>		<p>Dreams and Goals: This unit will focus on the children identifying their own dreams and goals, as well as looking at perseverance when we find something difficult. This unit will explore the children’s skills and abilities to work a group.</p>	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
<p>Vegetables: Children will learn how to say they would like a particular vegetable in Spanish using the ten vegetables covered in the previous lessons. They will also learn how to integrate a quantity / weight and how to say “please” in Spanish. They will have a choice as to which quantity / weight of each vegetable they want as they will learn how to say “half a kilo of...” and “one kilo of...” in this lesson.</p>		<p>Team building This half term children will be focussing on activities and games with a focus on working together in teams and the importance of good communication to succeed</p>	
Computing		Music	
<p>Word processing: This half term we will be focussing on our word processing skills. Within this the children will be using the spacebar and backspace, practising typing and making simple alterations to text using buttons on a word processor.</p>		<p>Zoo time: This is a six-week Unit of Work. All the learning is focused around one song: Zoo time. The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, the interrelated dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked</p>
