



English		Mathematics	
Children will be writing a narrative from an alternative perspective based on Theseus and the Minotaur. Later this term, children will study instructions before composing their own.		Pupils are looking at place value, identifying the correct value of a digit, comparing numbers up to 1,000,000 and finding 10,000 more and less of a number.	
Reading		Science	
Children are reading 'The Witches' by Roald Dahl and answering retrieval and inference questions. We are exploring new vocabulary together.		In the unit of learning 'Living Things and Their Habitats' the children will learn about the process of reproduction and the life cycles of plants, mammals, amphibians, insects and birds.	
Art		History	
Coinciding with our history topic, children will look at materials and decorations made popular by the ancient Greeks and recreate similar designs.		Year 5 will be studying Ancient Greece. They will be studying Ancient Greek life and achievements, and their influence on the western world. The children will learn all about the Olympic games then and now, Greek gods and goddesses and the Trojan War.	
Religious Education		Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)	
Pupils will be studying Sikhism. They will talk about how Sikhs show their commitment to God and what the Sikh Golden Rules are.		In the 'Being me in my world' unit the children will focus on identifying goals and setting targets for the year. We will also focus our roles and responsibilities as citizens within our community.
