English		Mathematics	
In English, we will be focusing on a unit of narrative, followed by explanation texts. We will be using the text, the Iron Man, as the basis for our narrative writing.		In mathematics, we are starting the year off with a focus on number and place value. We will recognise the place value of a number and use this knowledge to compare and order numbers.	
Reading		Science	
We are going to be using the Iron Man as our Guided Reading text too. We will be learning to retrieve information from the text that is clear, infer and summarise. We will also learn about the Romans, to help us with our topic.		In Science, we are going to be learning about digestion and teeth. We will understand the different types of teeth are and their functions. We will also explore the different parts of the body that are required for digestion and their function.	
Art		History	
We will be using mirrors to explore reflections and how we can use them to create a drawing with reflections.		In History, we will be exploring the Romans. We will focus on why they invaded Britain, their innovations (such as roads) and their legacy.	
Religious Education		Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)	
We will be focusing on the religion of Buddhism, with a focus on the question: Is it possible for everyone to be happy? We will explore what makes the children happy and how different people will enjoy different things.		Our topic for PSHE is called 'Being Me in My World.' We will explore feelings associated with being included or excluded and how we can make others feel valued and included.	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
We will learn about some of the essential Spanish sound patterns / phonemes so children can improve their pronunciation. We will also teach the children the vocabulary for ten different fruits.		In Year 4, Morpurgo class will be swimming in the Autumn term. Lewis class will swim in the Spring term. Both classes will learn about football in their PE lessons, exploring different skills and how to play as a team.	



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Computing		Music	
We will learn about computing systems and networks, focusing on Search engines. We will explore how they work and how we can use them to focus our searches to find exactly what we want.		We will be learning about Abba and their music. As part of this unit, we will learn to sing the song Mamma Mia.
