English		Mathematics	
This half term in English, we will be learning about prepositions, adverbs of time and speech to write an adventure story inspired by the book 'The Stone Age Boy'.		In Mathematics, we will be learning how to count in multiples, explore the place value of numbers up to 1,000 and compare numbers up to 500.	
Reading		Science	
We will be reading texts and answering questions, using a variety of different skills looking at the texts 'The Stone Age Boy' and 'Fantastic Mr Fox'.		This half term, we will be learning about Rocks and Soil. The children will use their scientific skills to compare and group different rocks based on their physical properties. We will be exploring the rock cycle and how this is a vital component to the creation of fossils.	
Art		History	
This half term, Year Three will investigate how to create works of art using natural materials to reflect life in prehistoric Britain.		In our 'Stone Age to Iron Age' unit, we will learn how the Stone Age to Iron Age period impacted on life in Britain. The children will learn about how the Neolithic people began to farm and investigate how Stonehenge was built.	
Religious Education		Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)	
This half term, we will be learning about the importance of the River Ganges to Sanatanis and why they would make a pilgrimage there.		Our first Jigsaw unit is 'Being Me in My World'. We will learn to celebrate our individual strengths, identify our achievements and set personal goals.	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
In our Spanish lessons, the children will be learning to pronounce vowels and consonants.		The PE focus this term is rugby. The children will learn to keep possession of the ball using attacking skills. They will play uneven and then even sided games, developing strategies and social skills to manage games.	
Computing		Music	
This half term, we will be beginning to look at the concept of networks, learning how devices communicate. We will be identifying components, learning how information is shared.		This half term, the children will be learning how to play the recorder.
