English		Maths	
<p><b>Narrative:</b> During this unit, children will explore the text 'Street Child', a tale of an orphan in Victorian London. They will have opportunities to develop a variety of writing techniques and explore different styles and text types.</p> <p><b>Explanation Text:</b> Throughout our non-fiction unit, children will research, plan, write, edit and publish an explanation text on Victorian Social Reforms.</p> <p><b>Poetry:</b> Children will read 'The Spider and the Fly' – a poem written by Victorian author Mary Howitt. They will explore poetic devices such as repetition and alliteration and understand themes and morals of the poem.</p>		<p>Children use written formal methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They also practise mental strategies with both large and small numbers, using their understanding of place value. Children solve multi-step problems, choosing which operations and methods to use based on the context of the problem and the types of numbers involved. The use of concrete manipulatives will support children's understanding, especially where exchanges are required.</p>	
Reading		Science	
<p>In <b>Guided Reading</b> we will be reading the book 'Another Twist in the Tale' by Catherine Bruton.</p> <p><b>Read for 20</b> - Pupils will continue to develop the reading skills of retrieval, inference and clarification of vocabulary.</p>		<p><b>Light:</b> This unit will teach children about light; how we see things, shadows, reflection and refraction, and how rainbows are formed. The children will learn how light travels and how this enables us to see objects. They will work scientifically and collaboratively to carry out experiments involving light and how it travels.</p>	
Art		History	
<p><b>Master of print and pattern:</b> During this unit, we will study Victorian Art and will be exploring and critiquing the work of artist William Morris. Children will have the opportunity to replicate designs, as well as using different art techniques to create their own William Morris inspired designs.</p>		<p><b>The Age of Change: Queen Victoria's Britain.</b> This term we will study the impact of the Victorian Era in Britain and around the world. We will also learn about changes in work and living conditions as well as social reforms during this period.</p>

<p><b>Religion: Islam</b>  <b>Theme: Beliefs and Practices</b>            Throughout this unit, we will understand some of the ways Muslims show commitment to God and to evaluate whether there is a best way.</p>		<p><b>Being me in my world:</b> This unit will focus on identifying goals and setting targets for the year. We will also focus on our roles and responsibilities as citizens within our community.</p>	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
<p><b>La fonetica (Phonics and Pronunciation)</b>            Children will learn a selection of the key phonemes and practise their pronunciation as part of their language learning experience.</p>		<p><b>Invasion games:</b> This half term children will focus on the skills of Netball. Children will learn how to keep possession of the ball using attacking skills. They will practise the skills required to be a good team player and will take part in netball matches.</p>	
Computing		Music	
<p><b>Big Data 1 (Data Handling)</b>            This unit focuses on the understanding of the use of big data including barcodes, QR codes, infrared, and RFID technologies. Children will create and scan their own QR codes, manipulate real-time data in spreadsheets, and present their findings. They also analyse transport data to understand its usefulness to commuters.</p>		<p><b>Happy:</b>            All the learning in this unit is focused around one song: Happy, a Pop song by Pharrell Williams. There is an integrated approach to music where games, the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch), singing and playing instruments are all linked.</p>
