English		Maths	
<p>In English, we will be starting the term by writing biographies. We will choose a famous person that we know to write a biography about.</p> <p>Following that, we will be continuing to learn about narratives. We will take our learning from Autumn One and build on it in Autumn Two. Additionally, we will be writing poetry based on the theme of Winter and Christmas.</p>		<p>In Maths, we will be continuing our learning on Addition and Subtraction, focus on using formal written methods to add and subtract four-digit numbers. After that, we will be learning about multiplication and division. This will continue our times tables learning, as well as using formal written methods to multiply and divide.</p>	
Reading		Science	
<p>We are starting Autumn Two by reading the book 'Flow' by Pippa Goodheart. We will continue to retrieve information from the text, whilst inferring information which isn't always obvious in the text.</p>		<p>In Science, we are going to be continuing our learning about digestion. We will identify the organs involved, investigate how digestion works and recognise what we can do to improve digestion.</p>	
Design Technology		Geography	
<p>We will be introducing the children to cushions and textile design. We will explore different types of fabric, create a design for a cushion and learn how to sew a running stitch to attach fabric pieces.</p>		<p>In Geography, we will be learning about earthquakes. We will identify the layers of the Earth and understand how earthquakes are formed. We will also explore their impact on planet Earth.</p>

<p>We will be focusing on the religion of Christianity. We will explore the question: What is the most significant part of the nativity story for Christmas today?</p>		<p>Our topic for PSHE is called 'Celebrating Differences.'
