<b>English</b>		<b>Mathematics</b>	
This half term, we will be writing an alternative ending for the story 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne, using exciting vocabulary, time conjunctions and expanded noun phrases. We will then be learning how to write a non-chronological report.		This half term in mathematics, we will be focusing on multiplication and division. We will use arrays to represent number sentences and solve problems and we will also be learning to recall the six times table.	
<b>Reading</b>		<b>Science</b>	
We will be reading a range of recommended Year Three texts and answering questions using a variety of skills, such as making predictions, inference and summarising.		In Science, we will be learning about the human skeleton. We will learn the names of the main bones in the human body and how they protect our vital organs.	
<b>Art</b>		<b>History</b>	
In Art, we will be learning about Ancient Egyptian patterns, artefacts and designs. We will also learn how to write our names in hieroglyphics.		This term, we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will learn where Egypt is, find out about the pharaohs and gods, and be able to identify their key achievements.	
<b>Religious Education</b>		<b>Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)</b>	
This half term, we will be focusing on Jesus' miracles from the Bible. The question guiding this term's enquiry is, "Could Jesus heal people? Were these miracles, or is there another explanation?"		Our topic this half term, is called 'Dreams and Goals'. We will focus on the importance of showing determination and perseverance when tasks become challenging. We will discuss how to work as a team.	
<b>Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish</b>		<b>Physical Education</b>	
This half term, we will be learning the names of animals in Spanish and how to pronounce them correctly.		In our PE lessons, we will create dances in relation to an idea. We will develop our use of counting and rhythm.
