<b>English</b>		<b>Maths</b>	
In English, we will be focusing on a unit of newspaper reports, where children will learn to write their own. This will be followed by narrative, where the children will consolidate previous learning.		In Maths, we will be learning about to apply our multiplication and division skills to wider problems such as multiplying and dividing 2-digit by 1-digit numbers.	
<b>Reading</b>		<b>Science</b>	
We are starting the year off with the well-known book 'Billionaire Boy' by David Walliams. We will focus on retrieving and inferring information, as well as using dictionaries to find the meaning of new vocabulary.		In Science, we are going to be learning about sound. This includes understanding what sound is and how we hear sound.	
<b>Art</b>		<b>History</b>	
We will be linking art to our history topic by designing and crafting Viking shields. We will look at a range of examples, design our own version and make it, using a range of materials.		In history, we will be exploring the Vikings. We will focus on where they came from, why they invaded Britain, their daily life and their legacy.	
<b>Religious Education</b>		<b>Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)</b>	
We will be focusing on the religion of Judaism, with a focus on the question: How does celebrating Shavuot help Jewish children feel closer to God? We will explore the festival of Shavuot and recognise the importance of this in the Jewish community.		Our topic for PSHE is called 'Dreams and Goals.' We will explore what they are and how they can use these to prepare for later life.	
<b>Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish</b>		<b>Physical Education</b>	
We will learn about using Spanish in the classroom. By the end of this unit the children will have the knowledge and skills to present both orally and in written form about what they have and do not have in their pencil cases and/or school bag in Spanish.		In Year Four, Lewis class will be swimming in the Spring term. Both classes will take part in dance lessons in their PE lessons this term.
