Year Two
Spring Term 1

This term we will be learning
about Keeping Healthy,
Monarchs and Designing a flag.

Mathematics

In Maths, we are focusing on multiplication and division. Children will learn to make equal groups, use arrays and share amounts equally. Year 2 objectives include recalling the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables, solving simple word problems, and understanding the relationship between multiplication and division.

We will be revisiting number and place value to consolidate the children's learning. This will include revisiting addition and subtraction with one digit and two-digit numbers.

Science

This term, we will learn about staying healthy. Children will explore different types of healthy food and understand how exercise helps our bodies. We will take part in a fun activity to explain the importance of handwashing and how germs spread, and suggest ways we can stay healthy every day.

English

In Spring Term 1, Year 2, our narrative focus is *The Three Little Pigs*. We will be rewriting our own version of the story, thinking carefully about characters, settings and events. Children will also learn how to write newspaper reports and simple poems linked to the story, using capital letters, full stops and exciting vocabulary.

History

In History, we are focusing on *Majestic Monarchs*. We will learn key facts about Queen Elizabeth I's reign and explore what life was like during her time. Children will compare the time periods of Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria and describe Queen Victoria's impact on Britain's empire and society.

PHSE

We will be learning about our dreams and goals for PHSE. This will involve our steps to success, persevering and working with others.

ART

In Art, children will design their own flag, thinking carefully about colour, pattern and meaning. They will transfer their flag design onto fabric or paper and explore different tools and materials to join parts of a flag together. We will also learn what symmetry means and how it can be used in flag design.

PE

Our focus is dance. The children will learn to use simple movement patterns using their living memory. They will also be learning to use their speed for transitions of movement and shape.

Spanish

In Spanish, children will learn vocabulary linked to vegetables. They will name and recognise up to 10 vegetables in Spanish and attempt to spell some of these nouns, including the correct article. Children will use simple vocabulary and phrases to take part in a role play about buying vegetables from a market stall.

Computing

This term, our focus is word processing. Children will begin to learn how to touch type and understand how to use a word processor. They will learn how to add images to a text document and create a digital piece of writing.

RE

Children will learn why the Qur'an is important to Muslims, how it was received by Muhammad, how it is respected, and how it guides daily life and rules.
