Dear Parents and Carers

RE: Nut based products in school/Healthy Eating School

At Bonneygrove Primary School, the safety and well-being of every child and staff member is our highest priority. We have pupils and staff who live with severe peanut and nut allergies, and for them, even a tiny amount of exposure can cause a serious and potentially life-threatening allergic reaction known as anaphylaxis.

To help us protect these vulnerable members of our school community, we kindly ask all parents and carers **not to send your child to school with any food containing peanuts, nuts, or traces of nuts**. This includes items such as:

- Nut spreads (e.g., peanut butter, Nutella)
- Cereal bars or snack bars with nuts
- Biscuits, cakes, or other baked goods containing nuts
- Condiments like satay sauce
- Snack pots or any packaged foods with nuts

We understand that this can sometimes be challenging, but your co-operation is essential in creating a safe environment where every child can learn and play without risk.

Please take a moment to carefully check food labels before packing your child's snacks or lunches. If any nut-based products are found on school premises, they will be respectfully confiscated and disposed of immediately to prevent any risk.

Thank you sincerely for your understanding and support in keeping our school a safe and welcoming place for all children. Together, we can ensure that every pupil and staff member feels secure and cared for.
