








English		Maths	
In English, we will be writing our own version of the story <i>The Anglo-Saxon Boy</i> , using descriptive language, a range of conjunctions and fronted adverbials. We will then explore persuasive writing, looking at what makes an effective persuasive piece, before writing our own using success criteria.		This half term, we will be learning to measure and compare length and mass using standard units such as metres, centimetres, kilograms and grams. We will also practise adding and subtracting measurements, including length, mass and capacity. Children will explore simple 2D shapes by measuring their sides and learning how to find the perimeter.	
Reading		Science	
In our Reading lesson, we will be looking at a variety of texts including 'The Anglo-Saxon Boy' and answer questions using retrieval and inference skills.		This term's unit on plants will focus on the features of plants and what they need to be healthy and grow. We will also be planting our own seedlings and watching them grow in different conditions.	
Art		History	
In Art, we will be learning about Anglo-Saxon clay tiles. We will look at the patterns they used and then sculpt our own using air-drying clay.		In History, we will be learning all about The Anglo Saxons, including why they came to settle in Britain and what daily life was like for them.	
Religious Education		Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)	
We will be looking at Hinduism and learning about different deities and what they demonstrate about Brahman. They will also reflect on different ways people understand God.		The children will focus on their role in their relationships with friends and family and how to solve conflicts if they arise.	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
In this term, children will be learning the story 'Little Red Riding Hood' in Spanish. They will use picture and word cards to recognise and retain key vocabulary from the story.		In PE, Year Three will explore a range of athletics events, developing their speed and agility skills.	
Computing		Music	
This term in computing, the children will be learning about the importance of collecting data in 'data handling'. They will learn how to sort, filter and interpret data.		In this term, the children will continue their recorder lessons. They will start to play longer pieces of music.
