<b>English</b>		<b>Maths</b>	
Children will be studying persuasive writing for different purposes. Later in the half term, pupils will write narrative stories based on The Highwayman.		Pupils will continue to learn about fractions and then move onto decimals and percentages. Pupils will also continue to consolidate learning relating to the four operations.	
<b>Reading</b>		<b>Science</b>	
Children will read the mystery story 'Clockwork' by Philip Pullman.		This unit of learning is all about Forces. Pupils will learn about types of forces such as gravity, friction, water resistance and air resistance.	
<b>Art</b>		<b>History</b>	
This unit of learning is all about first world war propaganda posters. Pupils will explore a range of features from historical posters before designing and creating their own.		Year 5 will be studying WW1. They will look at how the war started, life for the soldiers in the trenches and also the role of the women during the war.	
<b>Religious Education</b>		<b>Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)</b>	
Pupils will be learning about actions and consequences. They will be studying the Hindu beliefs of karma and reincarnation.		In the 'Relationships' unit, pupils will focus on how to stay safe online, manage screen time, and confidently say no to uncomfortable situations.	
<b>Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish</b>		<b>Physical Education</b>	
This unit teaches pupils to have the knowledge and skills to speak about their home and where they live. They will learn the names for different rooms of a house.		In this unit, pupils are set challenges for distance and time that involve using different styles and combinations of running, jumping and throwing.
