Dear Parents and Carers

Our Bonneygrove Sports Day is due to be held on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June and we warmly welcome you to come and spectate. This will take place from 9.00 a.m. - 10.15 a.m. for Reception and Key Stage One children, and from 10.30 a.m. – 12.30 p.m. for Key Stage Two children.

All children will participate in a carousel of physical activities, followed by competitive races completed in House teams. During these activities, we kindly ask parents and carers to remain behind the marked spectator areas. Please also be reminded that there are no pets, alcohol or smoking (including vapes) permitted on the school premises.

Children can wear their sportswear all day and will be provided with a band signifying their House colour. We would like them to wear their house-coloured t-shirt (Daley – Green, Hamilton – Blue, Ennis-Hill – Yellow, Kenny – Red). Your child will also need a suitable hat, sunscreen and a clearly named bottle of water.

Following Sports Day, we would like to invite families to join us for a picnic lunch on the field from 12.30 p.m. – 1.30 p.m. Parents and carers are welcome to stay or return for the picnic. If your child is not accompanied by an adult, staff will supervise the children, and they will sit together with their friends and class teacher. Parents and carers are welcome to arrive and leave throughout the afternoon as needed. A member of staff will remain at the gate to support safeguarding procedures during the event.

Our canteen staff will prepare sandwiches for any children who pre-order them. Families are also welcome to bring their own picnic food; however, please ensure that no food containing nuts is brought onto the school premises due to allergies.

At 1.30 p.m., all children will return indoors to be registered for the afternoon session before returning outside for an additional hour of games and activities on the field. Parents and carers are welcome to stay for these activities; however, all visitors must leave the school premises by 2.30 p.m. Children will then be collected at the normal end-of-day time of 3.15 p.m.

Should Sports Day need to be postponed in the event of bad weather, the alternative date will be Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2026.

We look forward to an enjoyable and successful Sports Day for all children and families.
