English		Maths	
Children will be writing a narrative from an alternative perspective. Later this term, children will study playscripts before composing their own.		Pupils will learn to add and subtract decimals with a different number of decimal places. Following this, children will learn about units of measurement.	
Reading		Science	
Children will be reading Harry Potter and focussing on continuing to develop their retrieval, inference and vocabulary skills.		Children will learn how the human body works and how exercise, diet, and lifestyle affect health by studying the circulatory and digestive systems and recording simple data about the body.	
Design Technology		Geography	
This unit of learning is all about bags. Pupils will design and make a functional bag by researching designs, selecting suitable materials, learning sewing techniques, and evaluating their finished product.		Year 5 will learn about Africa's geography, physical features, cultures, economies, and climates by using maps, comparing regions and countries, and exploring how people live in different environments.	
Religious Education		Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)	
Pupils will be learning about Christianity. They will contemplate different ways people show commitment to God and evaluate if there is a best way.		In the 'Changing Me' unit, pupils will learn about puberty for boys and girls. They will think ahead to becoming a teenager and what changes this will bring to their lives.	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
Pupils will learn and practise days, months, and numbers 1–31 in Spanish so they can say the date and their birthday.		In the cricket unit, pupils will develop their understanding of the game. They will need to use skills, strategies and tactics to outwit their opponents.	
Computing		Music	
In this computing unit, pupils will learn about how images are represented by digital devices and use 3D design software.		This Unit of Work consolidates the learning that has occurred during the year. All the learning is focused around revisiting songs and musical activities.
