English		Maths	
In English, we will be focusing on a unit of playscripts, where children will learn write playscripts, including stage directions for the reader. This will be followed by narrative, where the children will consolidate previous learning.		In Maths, we will be learning about measurement, particularly perimeter. Then we will move onto shape and position and direction. Finally, we will learn about statistics.	
Reading		Science	
We are reading the book 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe' and will be using this to retrieve answers, infer information that isn't clear in the text and identify new vocabulary.		In Science, we are going to be learning about electricity. Within this unit, children will learn where electricity comes from, create basic circuits and use technical vocabulary.	
DT		Geography	
We will be using learning how to cook ratatouille and couscous. We learn how to prepare the food, how to cook safely and experience different foods.		In geography, we will be learning about islands. We will explore how they are formed, different characteristics of islands and some of the challenges they face.	
Religious Education		Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)	
We will be focusing on the religion of Christianity, with a focus on the question: Do people need to go to church to show they are Christians? We will explore the importance of worship, baptism and communion to Christians.		Our topic for PSHE is called 'Changing Me.' We will summarise the changes that happen to boys' and girls' bodies that prepare them for making a baby when they are older.	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
In this unit, the children will learn about Healthy lifestyles, naming food and drinks in Spanish. They will also explain how to maintain a healthy lifestyle using their Spanish vocabulary.		In Year Four, we will continue to refine our athletics skills in their PE lessons this term, in preparation for Sports Day.
