English		Maths	
We will be looking at and writing playscripts, thinking about how they are set out and how we can add adverbs within stage directions. We will also be writing a story based on 'The Extraordinary Gardener'.		Geometry: This half term, we will learn how to draw and build 2D and 3D shapes. We will explore angles, including right angles, and find them in shapes and everyday objects. We will also learn about half, three-quarter and full turns, using mathematical vocabulary to describe direction and movement accurately.	
Reading		Science	
We will be reading texts and answering questions using a variety of different skills looking at the text, 'The Extraordinary Gardener' by Samantha Boughton.		Plants: This term we will be continuing to look at plants and what a healthy plant needs to survive. We will be planting and caring for our own Marigolds.	
Design Technology		Geography	
Bake It 'Till You Make It: This half term, we will learn how bread is made, exploring the ingredients used and the steps involved in the baking process. We will develop practical skills such as kneading, shaping and proving dough, and discover how heat transforms dough into bread. We will also evaluate our finished products and reflect on how we could improve our bread-making skills.		Exploring Europe: This half term, we will explore the countries of Europe, locating them and their capital cities on maps. We will investigate Europe's physical features, including mountains, rivers and climate zones, and compare the geography of the UK with another European country. We will also learn about different cultures, languages and ways of life across Europe, using maps, atlases and digital tools to support our learning.	
Religious Education		Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)	
Sikhism: This half term, we will learn about the Khalsa and the Amrit ceremony, including the Five Ks and their meaning. We will explore why some Sikhs choose to join the Khalsa and reflect on ideas of commitment, belonging and how Sikhs show their faith in different ways.		This half term, we will learn about how boys' and girls' bodies change as they grow, both inside and outside. We will also reflect on the changes that come with growing up, sharing what we may feel excited or worried about and learning that different feelings are normal.	
Modern Foreign Languages: Spanish		Physical Education	
Shapes: This half term, we will learn five common shapes in Spanish and begin to use simple vocabulary to describe appearance. We will practise recognising, saying and using new words in spoken and written sentences.		Cricket: In this unit pupils develop their understanding of the batting and bowling principles of cricket	
Computing		Music	
Data Handling: This half term, we will learn about databases and how data is stored, organised and used. We will compare paper and computerised databases, and develop skills in sorting, filtering, interpreting and representing data in different ways for a specific purpose.		Recorders: This half term, we will learn to play the recorder in simple ensemble pieces, using notation when ready and developing the ability to play by ear. We will focus on performing together with others, listening carefully and improving our musical skills.
