English

In English we have been exploring the structure of narrative and what this involves. Through exploring a familiar story, we have been able to extend and create new scenes using our imagination. The challenge is to create a piece of creative writing, challenging them to think through general aspects as well as specific plots to ensure everything is covered and checked in the editing process.

PHSE

Our second Jigsaw unit is 'Celebrating Difference'. Here we will explore our differences and work on strategies that support with conflict resolution.

Mathematics

In Mathematics this term we will continue to develop addition and subtraction skills within 3-dgit numbers.

Later in the term we will focus our learning on multiplication and division. We will consolidate previous learning of making equal groups of 2, 5 and 10. Following this we will move on to learning the 4- and 8-times tables.

Geography

In Geography we have been exploring the local community, using maps to identify local amenities. The children have been excited to discuss local jobs and the skill set required. Through out this term we will continue to use our map skills to identify and locate countries and capitals around Europe.





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Science

This term's unit on light will teach broaden the children's knowledge about light, reflections, and shadows. They will learn about different sources of light, and that we need light to see. Furthermore, they will learn that the sun's light can be dangerous and will create an information leaflet about keeping safe in the sun.

RE

We will be focusing on Christianity this term. Each week we will build upon our thoughts and ideas to discuss whether Christmas has lost its true meaning. The children will work through a series of lessons and use the information gathered to provide their final ideas and conclusions.

PF

We will focus on improving the quality of gymnastic movements. The children will be introduced to the terms 'extension' and 'body tension.' They will develop the basic skills of rolling, jumping, and balancing and use them individually and in combination.

Computing

This term in computing year three will be learning how to use basic word-processing skills; various features for formatting text and important computer skills including screenshots and the Snipping Tool, and secure use of passwords.

Design and Technology

Our unit theme is 'Great British Dishes'.

We will be using cooking skills such as peeling, coring, and slicing to create an apple crumble.
