Autumn Term 2

English

Reading: This term we will be reading a range of traditional tales. We will also learn familiar nursery rhymes and the Makaton to accompany them. **Phonics:** The children will covered phase 2 sounds and are beginning to sound talk and blend.

Writing: This term we are focusing on sound talking and blending CVC words.

We will be using the Kinetic letters scheme to help our pencil control and support forming letters correctly.

Practise writing your name in different ways and recognising letters in their environments. Use the wandle formation sheet to support letter formation.

Mathematics

This term we will be learning numbers to 5, how they can be made and subitising. We will be looking at 2D shapes and how to create pictures using these shapes.

Encourage counting in different settings. E.g. when going to the shops, counting out toys. Look for numbers to 5 in familiar settings. Go on a shape hunt!

This term we are learning about our families and communities. We are going to make family trees, family portraits and maps of our school.


You can join in with our learning at home by:
